7. All decisions made by the judges will be final.
8. Exhibits must be picked up on the final Saturday of the fair at 9:00 PM. Premiums and ribbons may also be picked up at this time.
9. Exhibits removed prior to the above time and date will forfeit premiums and ribbon awards
